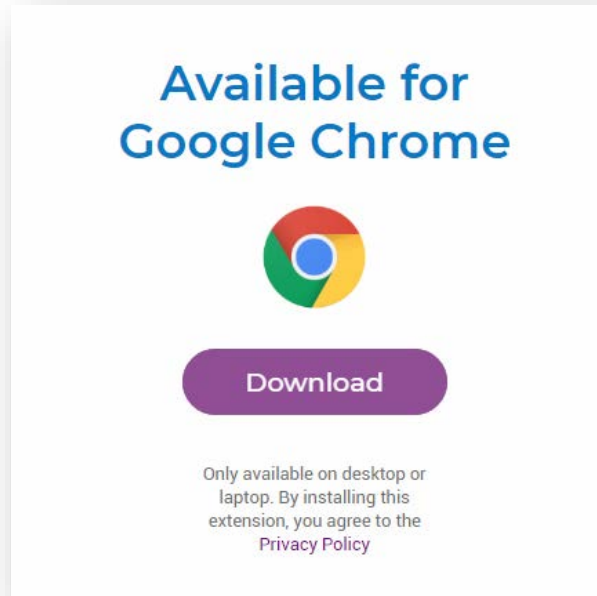
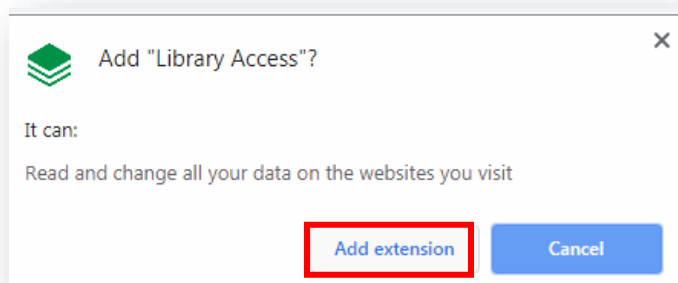
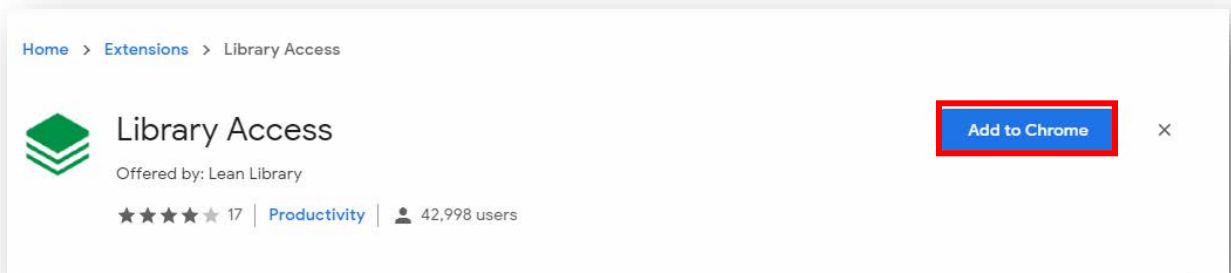


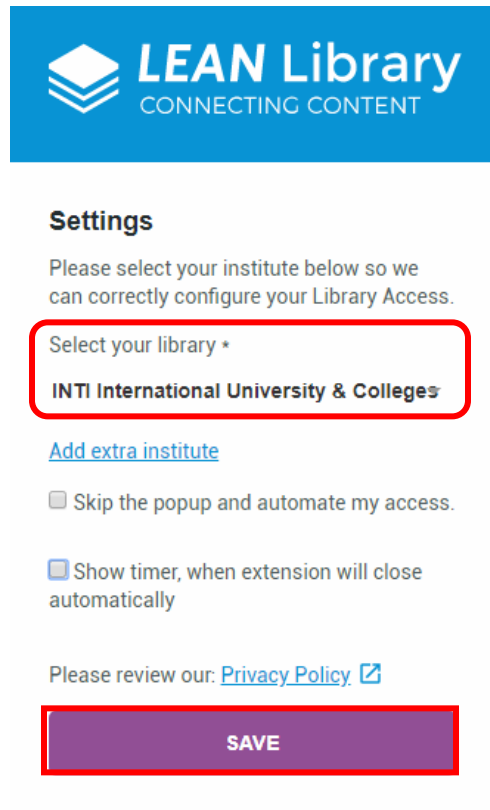
1. Go to www.leanlibrary.com/download.
2. Click **Download**.




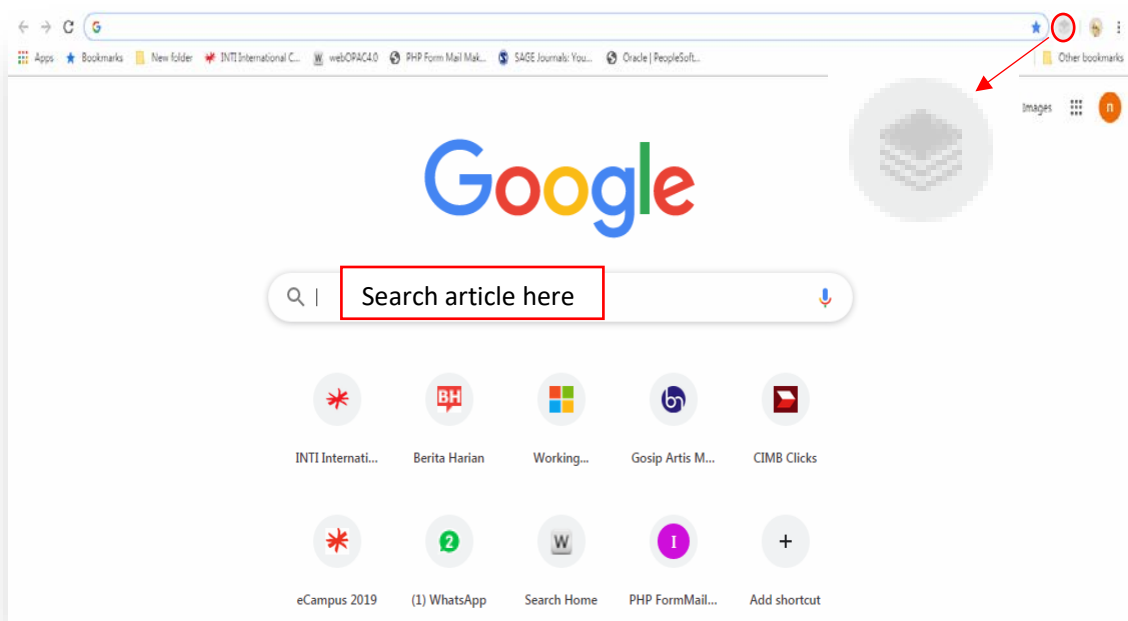
3. Click on **Add to Chrome** to add the **Lean Library extension** into your web browser.
